The combination of ESS's optimized air-assist Electrostatic Sprayer with ESI's EnviroTru[®] Disinfectant & Cleaner Deodorizer will produce a superior solution across a host of industries where uniform coverage and maximum efficiency is required to help prevent the spread of infectious microorganisms while minimizing the harmful effects to people, surfaces and the environment.

The decontamination and remediation system disperses fine electrically charged droplets of EnviroTru[®] into the air. Because of the ESS induction static charge imparted to aerosol particles, the ESS sprayer delivers a much higher amount of EnviroTru[®] on targeted surfaces than conventional air assisted spray systems; approximately 60% of the total disinfectant is dispensed on the surface by the ESS sprayer, versus less than 15% for conventional sprayers.

The combined system advantages:

- Populated locations that could not be previously sprayed because of concerns related to toxic exposure of other disinfectants can now use our system.
- High traffic and large areas that require frequent applications can now utilize a more effective method to apply EnviroTru[®].
- Difficult to reach areas can now be treated due to the principles of the combined technology.
- Businesses with manpower considerations can now utilize a more efficient decontamination process.
